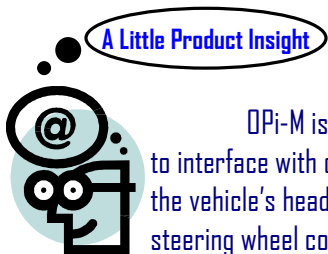

Congratulations on purchasing your Nav-TV Corp. OPi-M interface. Please read this guide to learn about the features of your OPi-M, how to use its controls, and more.

OPi-M



A Little Product Insight

OPi-M is a direct iPod interface developed for Mercedes Benz vehicles utilizing the MOST fiber optic bus. OPi-M is designed to interface with current versions of the iPod and iPod Nano. Once installed, OPi-M allows the ability to control iPod functions from the vehicle's head unit, and also allows partial control of iPod functions (volume adjustment and track control) from the vehicle's steering wheel controls. To minimize driver distraction, the iPod buttons will not respond while the iPod is docked and the OPi-M is active (feature can be overridden by using the manual control feature). While the iPod is docked with the OPi-M interface, the iPod will automatically begin charging. In order to activate the OPi-M your radio must be in CD changer mode. Vehicles equipped with factory installed CD changers will lose the function of the CD changer once the OPi-M is installed. Vehicles that do not have a factory installed CD changer will not lose any radio functions.

Navigating with the Opi-M User Interface

OPi-M emulates a factory CD changer, and also behaves similarly to the factory CD changer as well. Categorized searches such as Genres, Albums, Artists, or Playlists in increments of five. Below you will find the main buttons used to navigate throughout your categorized searches. We recommend that you spend some time familiarizing yourself with the features and operation of OPi-M while your vehicle is stationary. We incorporated several features into the product to allow quick and safe access to your favorite music or audio files using head unit controls as well as steering wheel controls.



Pressing the "CDC" button Toggles the radio into CD changer mode and also activates the OPi-M interface.



Main directional pad, used for iPod navigation. Using the Up/Down arrows on the pad allows you to scroll through menu options. Once your desired menu option is highlighted, pushing the "OK" button will select that option.



Used for volume adjustment, as well as, power for the head unit.



Press & hold to rewind through current track. Tap once once to browse previous tracks.



Press & hold to forward fast through current track. Tap once once to skip the current track.



When pressed once, loads the first categorized option in your current view & also pages back to your previous five categorized options (if available).



When pressed once, loads the second categorized option in your current view



When pressed once, loads the third categorized option in your current view



When pressed once, loads the fourth categorized option in your current view



When pressed once, loads the fifth categorized option in your current view & also pages forward to your next five categorized options (if available).



Accesses the Options / Aux In Menu.

OPi-M Library Navigation



OPi-M was engineered for iPod® lovers by iPod® lovers, with a common goal in mind. Simplicity. OPi-M puts the familiar iPod® menu right on your head unit, making OPi-M an extremely user friendly interface. Music and audio files are displayed as the same as they are stored on the iPod®. OPi-M allows you to browse music files by play lists, artists, albums, and genres. Before using your OPi-M, we recommend that you organize your audio files into categories on your iPod®. In order to browse your music library by play lists, access your main audio screen by pushing the audio button on your head unit.

Browsing by Categories

Organizing your iPod® music library into categories, allows stress-free browsing of your music library. Below you can find steps for browsing by play lists, artists, albums, and genres using your OPi-M interface.



Browsing by Playlists



- Step 1: Press the  button.
- Step 2: Use the Up/Down arrows to bring up the "Mode: Playlists" selection.
- Step 3: Once the "Mode: Playlists" is on the screen, press the  button.



Browsing by Albums



- Step 1: Press the  button.
- Step 2: Use the Up/Down arrows to bring up the "Mode: Albums" selection.
- Step 3: Once the "Mode: Albums" is on the screen, press the  button.



Browsing by Artists



- Step 1: Press the  button.
- Step 2: Use the Up/Down arrows to bring up the "Mode: Artists" selection.
- Step 3: Once the "Mode: Artists" is on the screen, press the  button.

Browsing by Genres





- Step 1: Press the  button.
- Step 2: Use the Up/Down arrows to bring up the "Mode: Genres" selection.
- Step 3: Once the "Mode: Genres" is on the screen, press the  button.

Activating Manual or Radio Controls


Activate Manual Control



- Step 1: Press the  button.

- Step 3: Once the "Manual Control" is on the screen, press the  button.

Activate Radio Control



- Step 1: Press the  button.
- Step 2: Use the Up/Down arrows to bring up the "Radio Control" selection.
- Step 3: Once the "Radio Control" is on the screen, press the  button.

OPi-M kits with the auxiliary audio input will include a modified main harness (w/ two female RCA jacks for left & right audio input) and upgraded software. Once the OPi-M is completely installed, refer to the following in order to activate the auxiliary audio input.

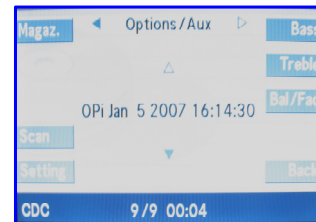


Activating Aux In
